1: Opening files with GIMP

- 1: Open the GIMP program.
- 2: To open an image file in GIMP, click "File" at the top left hand corner then choose "Open" from the drop-down menu.
- 3: The "Open Image" window pops up, showing all the image files you can open.
- 4: Find the image file from the folder you have stored the files in.

- **Anchor Links** enable you add links to content within the same page.
- This is useful for allowing users to navigate quickly through a long page of text to specific parts of the page
- **Anchor Links** can be added on one page that links to an **Anchor Name** on another page on the same website
- **Anchors** can link from one website page to content in another website page
- When the user clicks the **Anchor Link**, the page scrolls down to the **Anchor Name** on the page

2: Saving files with GIMP

Anchor Name

GIMP XCF image (*.xcf)

When working on images in GIMP it is best to save your work in the GIMP .xcf file format at regular intervals.

This will enable you to return to re-edit the position of layers and content of the images, without losing image quality, or the undo history dialog, or if you need to add an extra element to your image such as text or change the color, this is best done to a GIMP .xcf file.

How to save files with GIMP .xcf format

1: Click "File" at the top left hand corner of the GIMP program window then choose "Save As" from the drop-down menu.

2: The "Save Image" window pops up, showing all the image files you have saved.

3: Navigate to the folder where you want to save the image, in the "Save Image" window and click on the folder to highlight it. The image will be saved into that folder.

4: Type in a name for your image file in the "Name" box at the top of the "Save Image" window.

5: Make sure to add .xcf at the end of the image name, to save it in GIMP.xcf

2: Saving files with GIMP

Anchor Name

GIMP XCF image (*.xcf)

When working on images in GIMP it is best to save your work in the GIMP .xcf file format at regular intervals.

This will enable you to return to re-edit the position of layers and content of the images, without loosing image quality, or the undo history dialog, or if you need to add an extra element to your image such as text or change the color, this is best done to a GIMP .xcf file.

How to save files with GIMP .xcf format

1: Click "File" at the top left hand corner of the GIMP program window then choose "Save As" from the drop-down menu.

2: The "Save Image" window pops up, showing all the image files you have saved.

3: Navigate to the folder where you want to save the image, in the "Save Image" window and click on the folder to highlight it. The image will be saved into that folder.

4: Type in a name for your image file in the "Name" box at the top of the "Save Image" window.

5: Make sure to add .xcf at the end of the image name, to save it in GIMP.xcf
